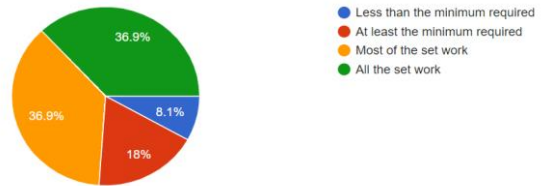
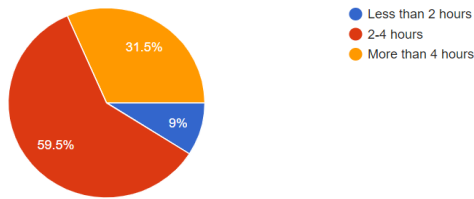
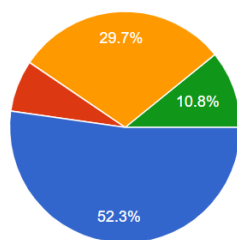


Parent Survey Results: 9th February: 111 responses

- 97% report no problems getting on Google Classroom, just occasional internet problems
- 98% say that the class teacher is providing a range of subjects from across the curriculum
- 80% find the amount of work about right, 15% too much



- 2/3 find a mix of live and pre-recorded their preferred option, ¼ prefer live sessions.

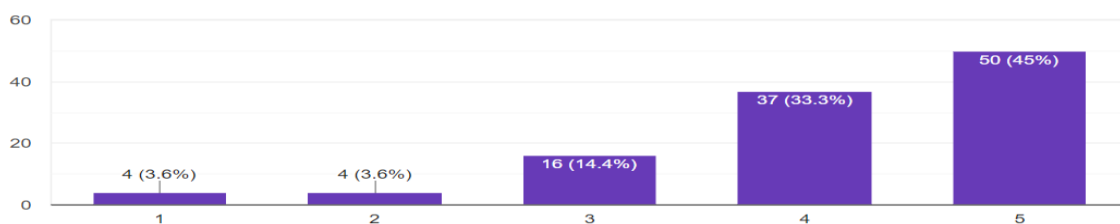


- My child is coping well with the work provided.
- My child finishes the work quickly and easily and would benefit from extra activities.
- My child only completes the work if they are given lots of support/rewards.
- I'm really struggling to get my child to do anything.

- Almost 20% of children are struggling with not being in school. Where names have been given, we have followed this up with parents.
- 41% of infant parents say they are able to support their child well. 39% say they can support them but it is difficult.
- Most junior parents say their child is able to access learning with relatively little support. 19% say they are having to help them with everything.
- 46% say their child is getting written feedback, 31% say it is a mixture of verbal and written. 14% say they don't know.
